What is rude or mean?

Rude

- ▶ Accidentally upsetting others
- ▶ Unplanned
- ▶ *E.g. Yuck. Your sandwiches are gross*
- ▶ *Bad manners – jumping in front of someone in the line*

Mean

- Purposely doing something to upset or hurt
- Isolated, not repeated
- *E.g. deliberately squashing someone's sandwich*
- *Pushing someone out of the way to get into line*



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What is bullying?



- Bullying is ongoing (happens multiple times)
- Targeted (a person is chosen)
- Deliberate (planned)
- Can be individual or group,
- Can be verbal, physical or online
